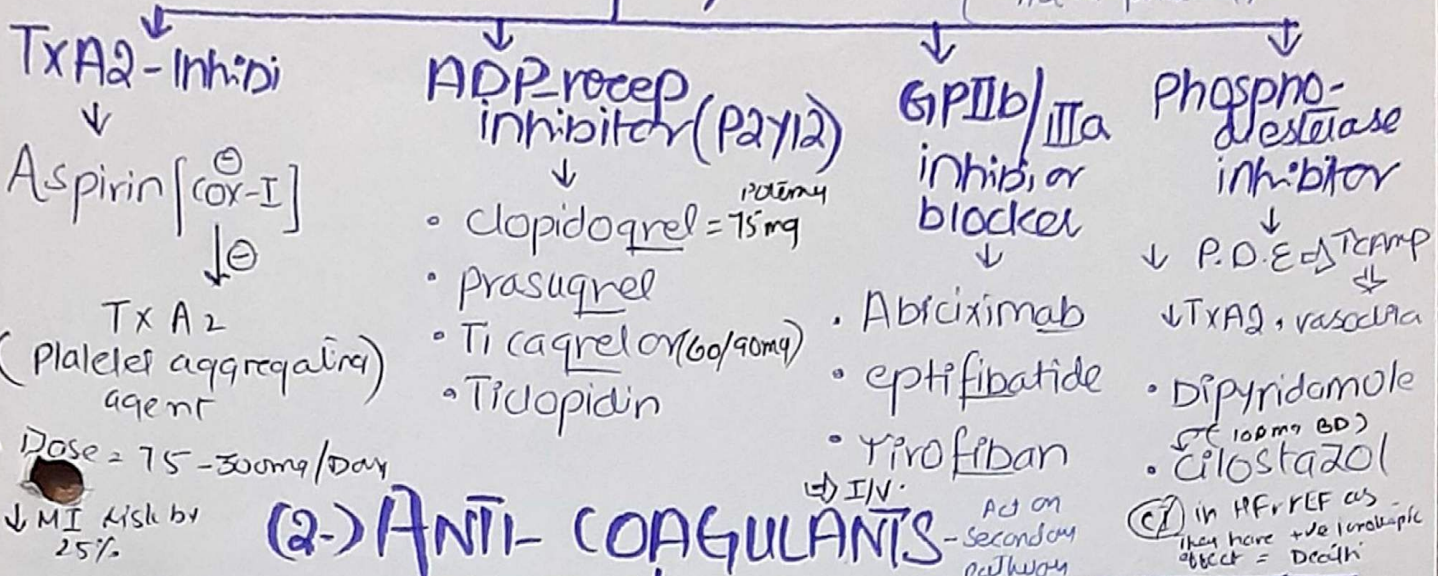
PRIMARY coag. Pathway



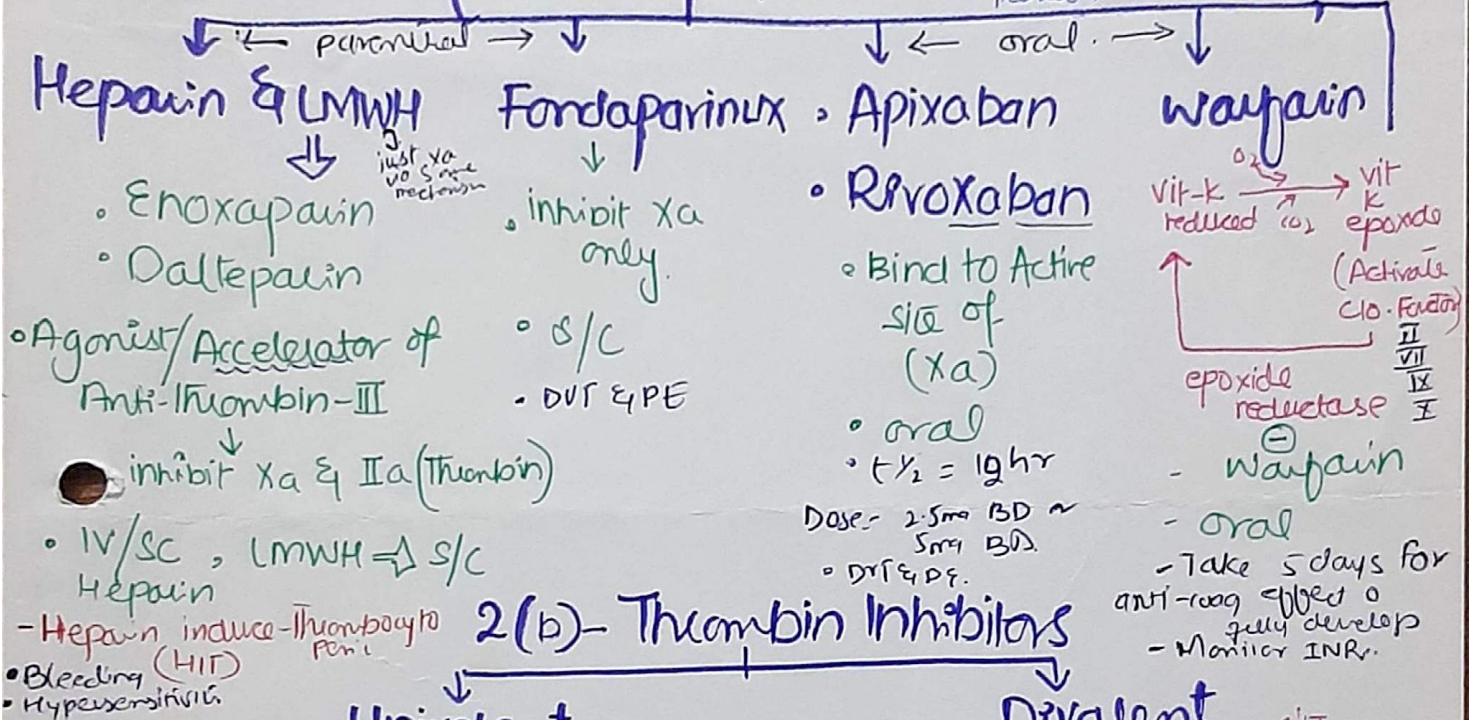
PT = Measures how quickly blood clots

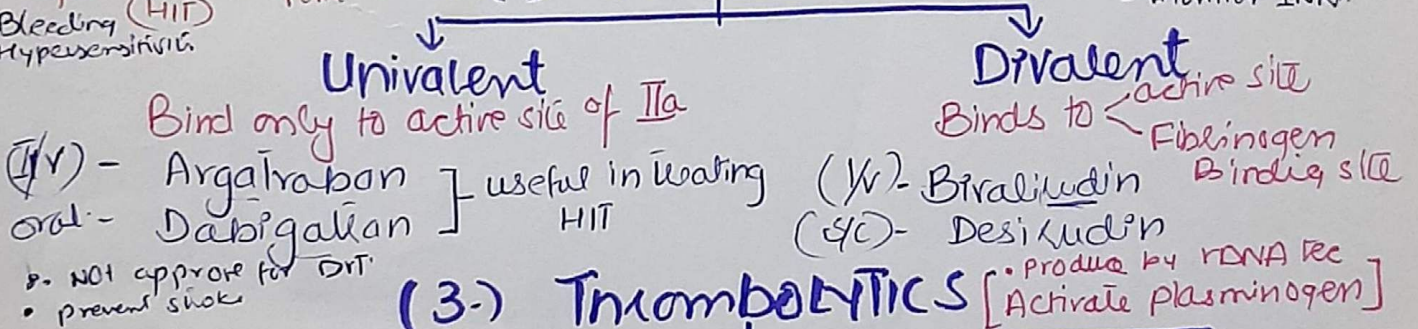

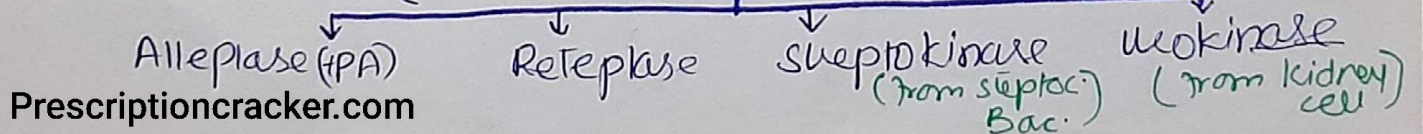
