

CONTROL OF NARCOTIC SUBS. ACT, 1997

Sec-5 (cultivation punis) 7 yrs, $\bar{e}$ / $\bar{e}$.o fine or both

Sec-9 (pun. possess, imp/exp, Trafficking)

- 2 yr + $\bar{e}$ / $\bar{e}$.o fine = $\leq 100g$.
- 1 yr + fine = $100g < 1kg$.
- Death/imp + life / upto 14 yr + fine = $> 1kg$.
- imp for life = $> 10kg$. (10 lac)
2 million

Sec-11 (pun. owning) ^{upto} 25 yr, NLT 10 yr + fine upto ^{premises, machinery, etc.}

Sec-13 (pun. acquisition) 5-14 yrs. + fine acc. to value of ^{NLT} assets ^{and possession of assets derived from offence}

Sec-15 (pun. aiding) (punishment provided for offence)

Sec-16 (if no punis provided) $\rightarrow$ 1 yr or 5000 rs or both

Sec-17 (obstine to officer) $\rightarrow$ rigorous puni $\rightarrow$ 3 yr $\bar{e}$ / $\bar{e}$.o fine

Sec-18 (limit of fine) (sp. court decide acc. to quantity & quality of drug/sub).

Sec-19 (Forfeiture) if sp. court sentence for MT 3 yrs then assets derivable from trafficking $\rightarrow$ forfeited. ^{shall stand}
