

THE - PHARMACY ACT - 1967 - 20th June

~ An act to establish pharmacy council to regulate the practice of pharmacy ~

- Medical institution:- an institution whose medical qualifications are recognised under Medical council ordinance 1962.
- Pakistan pharmacist Association - registered under Societies registration Act, 1860 (XXI of 1860) and known at the commencement of Pharmacy (Amendment) Act 1973 by that name.
- Pharmacist:- means a person who is registered under Sec-24 in reg. A or reg. B
- Pharmacy council of Pakistan - Estab. by fed. gov. & in 1st yr of commencement of this Act.
- Provincial pharmacy council = estab. by prov. gov. and will known by the name of province concerned
- Composition of central council:-
 - ① President = DG of health, GOP ex-officio (a person already appointed in high rank in Gov. dep. and get the presidential stamp a seal)
 - 11 members
 - ★ 8 person, nomin. by fed. gov. out of which one from each province - in consultation & prov. gov. concerned ~ one teacher of - ceutics & one teacher of ph. chem.
 - ★ one person from each provi. to be nomin. by fed. gov. in consult & prov. gov.
 - ★ one person to be nomin. by fed. gov. in consult & - Pak. pharmaceutical Association -
 - ★ "Drug controller - GOP.
- Composition of provincial Gov. council:-
 - ① President = Prov. Gov. Health dep., ex-officio (7 members)
 - ★ 5 members nomin. by P-G, out of whom 1 shall be officer of Gov.
 - ★ ① 1 person nomin. by prov. branch of PPA

- ★ Term of office - 3yr for members other than ex-officio
 • eligible for re-nomination
- ★ Vice-president of council will be selected every yr by elections
 ↳ tenure of V.P = 1yr (eligible for re-nomination)
- ★ Meetings of council — preside by president — in his absen = V.P
 ↳ in the absence of both = members elect one of the member to preside.

Quorum = $\frac{1}{3}$ rd of total members.

- ★ Central Council → Fed gov } submit annual report (money rec'd + expenses)
- ★ Prov. Council → Prov. gov }
- ★ Cen. Council approval of Fed gov } appoint a secretary, eligible for reg. as A
- ★ P.C. — Prov. gov }
- ★ A.P. — Fed Council } [PHARMACIST in REG-A]

⇒ Functions of central council :-

- 1) approve examinations in pharmacy
- 2) prescribe subjects (3) course of study & practical training for purpose of adm. in approd examination
- 4) condition & procedm. for adm in examn.
- 5) lay down standard of teaching (6) prescrib equip + facilities
- 7) To recognise degrees or diploma in pharm. for the purpose of reg. as pharmacists
- 8) inspection of institutions.

- Apprentices in pharmacy =

↳ Inspector of drug & G. Analysis appoin under Drug Act 1940 (XXIII of 1940), if not otherwise eligible for regisr

- person certified by Gov. HOS. to be qualified compounder/disps
- a person who has been taken as a student or apprentice in pharmacy & prodn certificate to that effect
- person qualified in meaning of Rule-65 of west-Pak Drug rules 1958

* - convict of any offence / unsound mind = NOT TO Be reg. As Pharmacist

— Procedure for registration —
(By provincial council)

↓
decide forms, fees/particulars

- provincial gov = examine application
- if reject any applicat = inform the applicant in 90 day of receipt of application

applicant will appeal in 60 day of receipt of info

* - Certificate of regisr by prov. council shall bear

- ① reg. number
- ② official seal of council
- ③ sign of president & secretary
- ④ passport size photo
- ⑤ sign of applicant
- ⑥ Mark of identification

∴ if certic is lost/deposed = same fee for duplicate

(i) unsound mind
(ii) convicted by court

Revocation of certificate: ① incur disqualification spec. in sub (3) of sec 25

② contravene any provision of Poison Act 1919, Dangerous Act 1930, Drug Act 1976

③ fail to comply w any directive in respect of profession of pharmacist w Fed gov / prov. gov.

④ guilty of professional misconduct.

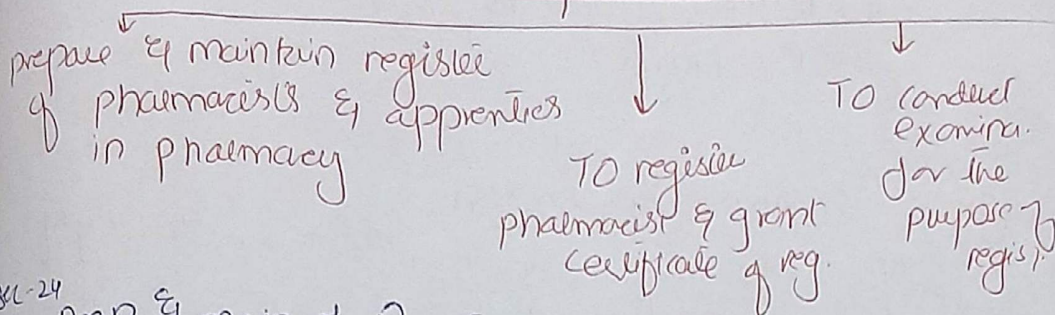

FUNCTIONS OF PROVINCIAL COUNCIL



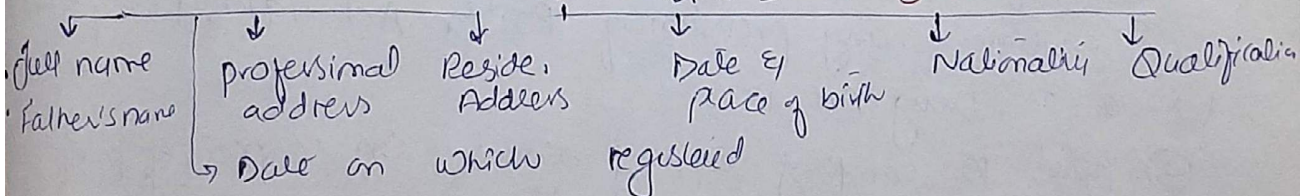

* Prohibition of practice & out Legislation

(1) → NO person shall after the expiry of 5 yrs from commencement
of this Act - practice as pharmacist unless he is registered
pharmacist + Display certificate of registr in which he/she practice

(2) → Employer of pharmacist = also should display C.O.R.
in which such business is carried on.
